BATANS JAMES BOND *FUNKHANA*



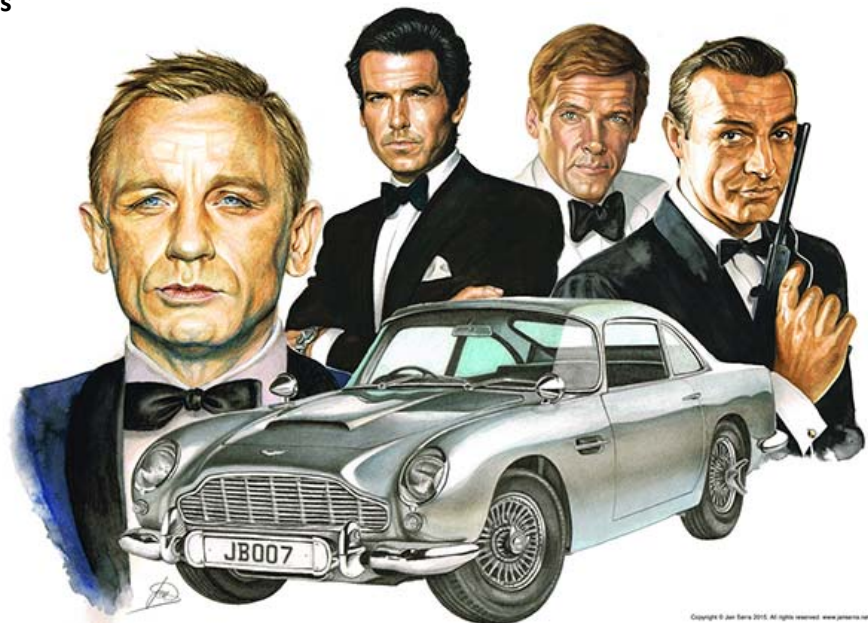
Since the First James Bond Film, Dr. No, in 1962, the renowned British secret agent 007 has owned a string of iconic cars, from the classic Aston Martin DB5 to the submersible Lotus Esprit. The string of classic films has brought us action, drama and romance; along with many gadgets from Q's workshop, clever one liner quips, beautiful bond girls, and sinister villains. While most of us may never own an Aston Martin, be able to eject our companion from the passenger seat, or serve her Majesty's secret service to save the world, some of these experiences will be recreated in the first ever funkhana hosted by the British Automobile Touring Association of Nova Scotia.

A funkhana is a competition similar to a gymkhana or autotest, where people drive their cars and complete tasks along with navigators. The object is for the driver and navigator to have FUN, while running the car through a series of stations or tasks and end up with the best time. The task may be performed by the driver or the navigator or both depending on the situation.

After proceeding through the course and accomplishing the tasks, the team continues to the finish line where the clock is stopped. Penalties (if any) are given by adding a predetermined number of seconds to the recorded time for each penalty accrued.

- Stirred, not Shaken
- Q's workshop
- License to Kill
- Smoke screen
